## About the Seminar-

North-East India for ages had been the destination of various sperms of migrant from different parts of this sub-continent. This process of migration has since been continues unabated till today. In the post independence period, the North-East India, especially Assam, provided shelter to large number of immigrants from East Bengal and Nepal. Even after independence, a considerable number of Hindu and Muslim immigrants came to this region and settled in char area, grazing land, reserve forest as well as government land. As such, the increasing toad of immigration has evolved as a deep concern in this region. The external as well as internal migrants of the region have not only endangered the political sovereignty of the people but also threatened the very security of the nation. The process of social polarization on the basis of change of demographic structure has already started in Assam. Today, the survival against this demographic aggression has become an intricate problem for the indigenous people who have distinct socio-cultural character from other sections of societies having a historical continuity with pre-invasion and pre-colonial societies. Gradually, they are losing their land and resources upon which they are dependent for their survival. The multiple human rights violation cases like arbitrary killing, child trafficking, child abusing and disappearances are going rampantly in this region.

There is a paucity of scientific studies on the migration patterns in pre-historical as well as the pro-historical periods and their impacts in this region. It is expected that this Seminar will definitely provide a platform to the researchers, academicians, administrators, policy makers, students and the leaders of different organizations and NGOs to raise the diverse issues and highlight the ways for resolution of this burning issue of migration at the national level.
